UPDATE - DAMAGED PEDESTRIAN FOOTBRIDGE AND TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNALS / PEDESTRIAN ROUTE

Following numerous requests for updates this information has eventually been sent to CPC.

CPC do not have any more information at this time and cannot answer questions on this. Please call 0345 310 1111 or email highwayenquiries@oxfordshire.gov.uk and ask to speak to the County Bridge Engineer.

UK Power Networks are currently planning a diversion of their Low Voltage power service that feeds the residents on the roads of Golden Hills and Wykeham Rise. This work involves the installation of approx. 250 linear metres of cable in a trench within the carriageway from a nearby sub-station. UK Power Networks currently have the worked scheduled in starting week commencing 20th August, and it is anticipated to take 3 weeks to complete.

Once the diversion of the power service is complete, we would be able to remove the damaged timber footbridge. This operation will require the closure of the carriageway for one day (off-peak hours from 9:30am – 3:30pm). We then plan to make some amendments to the West verge over the existing road bridge in order to make it wide enough and suitable for use by pedestrians. This work will be completed using the existing traffic signal arrangement currently in place, and will take approximately 2 further weeks to complete.

Based on the current position, we would anticipate removing the damaged footbridge week commencing 10th September, subject to completion of the UK Power Networks diversion work, and having the temporary traffic signals completely removed from the carriageway with a temporary footway in place by Friday 21st September. In the meantime, we will continue to progress discussions with the Chinnor and Princes Risborough Steam Railway Company insurers in order to determine the long-term strategy with regards to the repair and reinstatement of the damaged timber footbridge.

HIGHWAYS CONSULTATION – MILL LANE & ESTOVER WAY

Proposal to construct a) two speed cushions on Estover Way, south of the junction with Hedgerley, and b) a raised table (incorporating a new mini roundabout) located at the junction with Estover Way, extending approx 20m into each of the adjacent roads. The aim of the proposals is to help improve road safety for all road users in the vicinity of the adjacent residential development. The proposed scheme can be viewed at

APPEAL NEWS

Persimmon Homes and Cala - Appeal continues, in the Community Pavilion on: 2, 4, 5 October 2018

The decision for these appeals is still due to be made before the end of the year but with the extended dates being announced sadly we do not yet have a decision date timescale.

The Appeal for 7 dwellings at land rear of 59-63 Lower Icknield Way – written representations submitted – being determined by letter evidence and not a formal hearing.

The Appeal for 51 dwellings at land rear of Doveleat – being determined by a formal appeal hearing – dates to be confirmed but likely to be towards the end of 2018.
