PARISH OF CHINNOR – CHINNOR, HENTON, EMMINGTON, WAINHILL AND CHINNOR HILL.

Would you be interested in becoming a Parish Councillor for the Chinnor Parish? Elections will be held on 2nd May 2019 - Councillors are elected every four years. Chinnor Parish has an allocation for 13 Parish Councillors on a voluntary basis. Information packs for potential CPC candidates - now available. The pack is full of information about being a Councillor for Chinnor Parish and what a Councillor does... and why!
All details about the nomination form are in the CPC pack – request one today.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Nominations may be submitted from 26th March (but not on Saturdays or Sundays).

The final date and time for their receipt in the elections office will be 4 pm on Wednesday 3 April 2019.

Nomination papers must be delivered by hand (NOT emailed or posted as they need to be checked over) to the council offices at 135 Eastern Avenue, Milton Park, Milton OX14 4SB.

To qualify as a candidate a person must, on both the day of nomination and the day of the election, be 18 years of age or over and a British or Commonwealth citizen, or a citizen of the Republic of Ireland, or a citizen of another Member State of the European Union.

In addition, the candidate must also meet at least one of the following four qualifications, again both on the day they are nominated and on polling day:

- (a) be registered as a local government elector within the parish; or
- (b) have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises during the previous twelve months within the parish; or
- (c) his/her principal or only place of work during the previous twelve months has been in the area of the parish; or
- (d) have resided within the parish or within 4.8 kilometres (three miles) thereof during the previous twelve months.
