

POSTERS IN CHINNOR

Poster Policy 2012

Chinnor Parish Council has the agency from Oxfordshire County Council to monitor the posting of notices, advertisements, etc. in the village, Mr. T. Hipkin being the named person who is authorised to remove posters which are deemed to be illegal, dangerous or against the policy of the Parish Council or Oxfordshire County Council.

The following is meant as an informal guide for organisations in Chinnor.

No posters must be put up at or around the following areas as they are known accident spots: -

- The Crown cross roads
- The Bird in Hand cross roads
- The junction on Chinnor Hill known as the Gooseneck.

No posters are to be put up in any bus shelters.

No more than two posters on any one street or road.

Posters must not be put up more than two weeks before an event and must be removed within one week after the end of an event.

No commercial posters

Any posters which are offensive will be removed immediately.

Advertisements for events outside the village will only be allowed with the previous consent of the Parish Council.

No posters to be put on trees.
